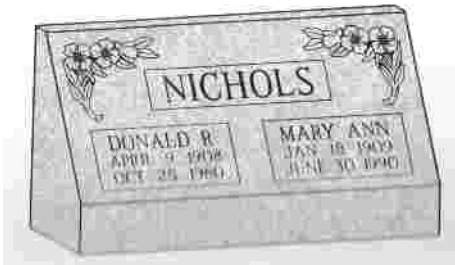

### Grave Marker Policy and Descriptions

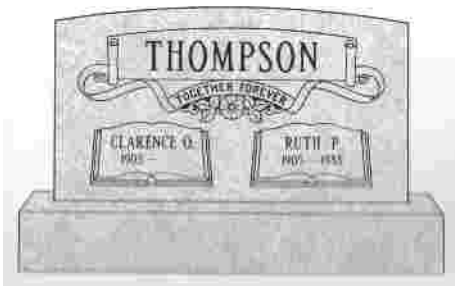


Wedge/Slant style stone

Used for individual or companion.

Can be used in all sections except, Section 1A, Baby land and Cremation Garden.

General guideline for size 24" in length per grave space covered.



Monument

Can be used in Section 4A, 7 for one or two graves. Size restriction of base is 24" per grave site.

To use in other sections, must have at least 4 graves, 2 on West side of marker, and 2 on East side of marker. Marker must be used for all for names.



Ground level marker.

Must be used in Sections 1A, Baby land and Cremation Garden ground interments.

Maximum size for Baby land in Section 2A 20" x 10"

Maximum size for Infants in Tier 14 Section 1a. 20" x 10" and must be sawed sides.

Cremation Garden, only size options are 24" x 12" for companion, and 16" x 8" for individual.



Bronze marker for Columbarium.

Only size and shape for Columbarium unit. No exceptions.

Size is 11" x 3-5/8".

Available in individual and companion.

All grave markers must be approved through Pine Hill Cemetery before making final purchase. All monument companies are made aware of our policies. All grave markers must have concrete foundation poured prior to installing marker. All foundations are poured by Pine Hill Cemetery.
